



2017 Regular Legislative Session

GENERAL BUSINESS BILLS THAT PASSED

HB 211 by Foil, Appel, Effective 8-1-17

Provides relative to business filings with the secretary of state.

HB 237 by Barras, Effective 6-14-17

Extends the sunset for the Enterprise Zone Program.

HB 244 by Hilferty, Effective 8-1-17

Allows certain business records to be self-authenticated.

HB 310 by Reynolds, Effective 8-1-17

Provides for revisions to the Business Corporations Act.

HB 435 by Talbot, Effective 8-1-17

Requires disclosure to patient of out-of-network providers prior to surgery.

HB 454 by Abramson, Effective becomes Act 345

Extends the sunset and provides for the amount of the Angel Investor Tax Credit.

HB 487 by Landry, Effective 8-1-17

Relative to fraudulent or fictitious identification credentials.

HB 590 by Hilferty, Effective 6-22-17

Provides for a review of and recommendation on certain dedicated funds.

SB 4 by Martiny, Effective 6-4-17

Provides relative to the registration of investment adviser representatives.

SB 36 by Martiny, Effective 8-1-17

Provides relative to the use of employment contracts in hospital service districts.

SB 104 by Appel, Effective 8-1-17

Provides relative to bid procedures for contractors.

SB 109 by Claitor, Effective 6-12-17

Provides for the suspension of prescription during certain emergencies and disasters.

INSURANCE BILLS THAT PASSED



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HB 165 by Anders, Smith, Effective 1-1-18

Provides for identification of dental benefit plan coverage relative to health insurers.

TAX BILLS THAT PASSED

HB 264 by Bishop, Effective 6-14-17

Specifies the types of construction contracts eligible for exclusion from the levy of a new state or local sales and use tax.

HB 300 by Davis, Effective 6-22-17

Provides relative to the amount of the research and development tax credit and authorizes transferability of the credit under certain circumstances.

HB 555 by Jackson, Effective 1-1-18

Provides relative to the corporate income tax deduction for certain dividend income.

HB 639 by Schexnayder, Effective 7-1-17

Excludes compensation earned by certain out-of-state employees and nonresident businesses for disaster or emergency-related work performed during disaster periods from state income tax.

SB 30 by Morrell, Effective 6-22-17

Extends the Tax Free Shopping Program set to terminate on July 1, 2017.

REGULATORY BILLS THAT PASSED

HB 307 by Lyons, Effective 6-14-17

Requires a tax clearance from the Dept. of Revenue for certain licenses, permits, tax resale certificates, and state contracts.

HB 333 by Jefferson, Effective 6-12-17

Authorizes the secretary of the Dept. of Revenue to require the filing of electronic tax returns and the payment of taxes by electronic funds transfer.

HB 601 by Stokes, Effective 6-16-17

Establishes the Louisiana Uniform Local Sales Tax Board and the Louisiana Sales and Use Tax Commission for Remote Sellers.
