



2010 REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION

GENERAL BUSINESS BILLS THAT PASSED:

HB 57 by Danahay, Effective 8-15-10

Increases penalty for violation of private investigator law.

HB 60 by Wooton, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 346

Amends concealed handgun permit laws.

HB 123 by Baldone, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 351

Creates the crime of tampering with surveillance, accounting, inventory, or monitoring systems.

HB 180 by Roy, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 355

Amends provisions regarding criminal background checks.

HB 368 by Arnold, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 366

Allows an extender of credit to charge fees and expenses in certain situations.

HB 429 by Chandler, Effective 8-15-10

Exempts certain court reporters from certification requirements.

HB 430 by Pugh, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 40

Requires stamp or label identifying farm of origin of strawberries.

HB 547 by Arnold, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 96

Provides relative to fees charged on consumer credit transactions.

HB 556 by Wooton, Effective 8-15-10

Amends firearm-free zone provisions with respect to concealed handgun permit holders.

HB 666 by Nowlin, Effective upon signature by the governor

Authorizes a taxpayer to recover attorney fees under certain circumstances.

HB 685 by Jones, Sam, Effective 8-15-10

Raises minimum age at which certain children may attend BESE-approved adult education programs rather than attending school from 16 to 17.

HB 1023 by Foil, Effective 8-15-10

Provides relative to outdoor advertising.

HB 1421 by Landry, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 417
Provides for low-profit limited liability companies.

SB 71 by Appel, Effective 7-1-10
Requires state and local contractors to disclose the full disposition, splitting, or sharing of contract commissions, fees, or other consideration by an "affidavit of notice of fee disposition" if the contract is let without bid.

SB 98 by Martiny, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 60
Provides relative to change in ownership of certain pawnshops.

SB 162 by Adley, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 163
Prohibits certain practices regarding the sale of fuel during a declared state of emergency.

SB 194 by Duplessis, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 164
Provides relative to employment contracts.

SB 228 by Duplessis, Effective 8-15-10
Provides relative to credit reporting security.

SB 256 by Chaisson, Effective upon signature by the governor
Enacts the Louisiana Exchange Sale of Receivables Act.

SB 291 by Donahue, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 67
Requires nonresident contractors to include its tax identification number on permit applications along with proof that contractor has registered to do business in the state.

SB 318 by Heitmeier, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 172
Requires certain notification regarding donation receptacles of commercial businesses.

SB 342 by Marionneaux, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 174
Provides relative to gift certificates.

SB 725 by Duplessis, Effective 8-15-10
Provides for disclosure of applicable fees in credit contracts.

SB 780 by Cheek, Effective upon signature by the governor
Provides for registration and certain employment activities for sex offenders.

INSURANCE BILLS THAT PASSED:

HB 244 by Kleckley, Effective 9-23-10
Provides relative to health insurance coverage of unmarried dependent children.

HB 744 by Roy, Effective 9-23-10
Limits discontinuation or cancellation of health insurance coverage under certain circumstances.

HB 821 by Kleckley, Effective 6-17-10 - Act 280

Provides for voluntary wellness or health improvement programs to be offered by health insurance issuers.

HCSR 4 by Barrow, Effective 6-7-10

Requests the House and Senate insurance committees to study requiring health insurance coverage of an annual screening for sexually transmitted diseases.

SB 106 by Riser, Effective 5-11-10 - Act 3

Provides relative to workers' compensation as relates to an examination of an injured employee when certain disputes arise.

SB 107 by Riser, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 120

Provides with respect to those included in the workers' compensation system.

SB 705 by Donahue, Effective 8-15-10

Provides for group health insurance coverage involving a trust for multiple associations and members and employees of these associations.

SB 732 by Hebert, Effective 8-15-10

Provides for balance billing disclosure requirements.

TAX BILLS THAT PASSED:

HB 300 by Ritchie, Effective 7-1-10

Authorization for the Louisiana Tax Commission to levy and collect certain fees.

HB 301 by Ritchie, Effective 7-1-10

Grants the La. Tax Commission the authority to manage its own budget, procurement, and general management and operational functions.

HB 448 by Foil, Effective 8-15-10

Provides for changes to reporting requirements of secondhand dealers.

HB 845 by Nowlin, Effective upon signature by the governor

Provides relative to requirements for private contracts with agencies or firms for the collection of local sales and use tax.

HB 873 by Smith, Patricia, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 288

Provides relative to workers' compensation as relates to penalties for employers who fail to secure coverage.

SB 296 by Martiny, Effective 8-15-10

Provides relative to the appointment and compensation of attorney or agency for municipal tax collections.

REGULATORY BILLS THAT PASSED:

HB 335 by Arnold, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 36

Provides for changes to licensing requirements for mortgage loan originators.

HB 795 by Wooton, Effective 8-15-10

Provides relative to an employer's access to criminal history and arrest records of a potential employee.

HB 981 by Jackson, G., Effective 8-15-10

Requires the recipient of certain economic development funds to adhere to certain hiring, purchasing, reporting, and repayment conditions.

HB 1052 by Jackson, G., Effective 8-15-10 - Act 399

Provides for a uniform definition of a disadvantaged business enterprise.

HB 1053 by Arnold, Effective 8-15-10

Provides relative to the Life Safety and Property Protection Licensing Act.

HB 1243 by Downs, Effective 8-15-10

Provides for announcement of time and place for public bids.

HB 1292 by Hines, Effective upon signature by the governor

Prohibits certain contractors from bidding on public projects. Substitute for HB 718.

HB 1380 by LeBas, Effective 8-15-10

Provides for the delinquent renewal of a license issued by the State Board of Home Inspectors.

HB 1407 by Foil, Effective upon signature by the governor

Repeals certain examination requirements of retail florists. Substitute for HB 450.

HB 1468 by Richmond, Effective 8-15-10 - Act 418

Provides for regulation of reverse mortgage lending. Substitute for HB 792.

SB 301 by Walsworth, Effective 8-15-10

Provides relative to the Incumbent Worker Training Program.

SB 707 by Alario, Effective 8-15-10

Provides for the definition of contractor for purposes of the occupational license tax.
